



A12 roadworks Ede – Grijsoord spring 2016

The roadworks on the A12 between Ede and Grijsoord are proceeding as planned and the results are clearly visible. The underpasses and flyovers are currently being finalised. In the summer, Rijkswaterstaat is expecting to be able to open the third lane. Until the work is finished around the summer of 2016, a few nightly and weekend closures of the A12 are planned between the Maanderbroek and Grijsoord interchanges. These closures will cause additional inconvenience for road users. In addition to the stated closures, there will be many traffic stoppages in the evenings and at night until the end of July.

Roadworks being performed over the next couple of months:

- Replacement of the asphalt on the existing lanes of the A12.
- Connection of the N224 to the new flyover.
- Demolition of the old flyover connected to the N224.
- Construction of a small wildlife tunnel underneath the A12.
- Modification of the traffic signs.

This will cause inconvenience for traffic.

A12 towards Arnhem: closures between Maanderbroek and Grijsoord interchanges

Including the Wageningen (24) and Oosterbeek (25) access roads towards Arnhem and the Wageningen (24) and Oosterbeek (25) exits coming from the direction of Utrecht.

Nightly closure

- Friday 8 April 10.00 pm until Saturday 9 April 08.00 am
- Friday 22 April 10.00 pm until Saturday 23 April 08.00 am

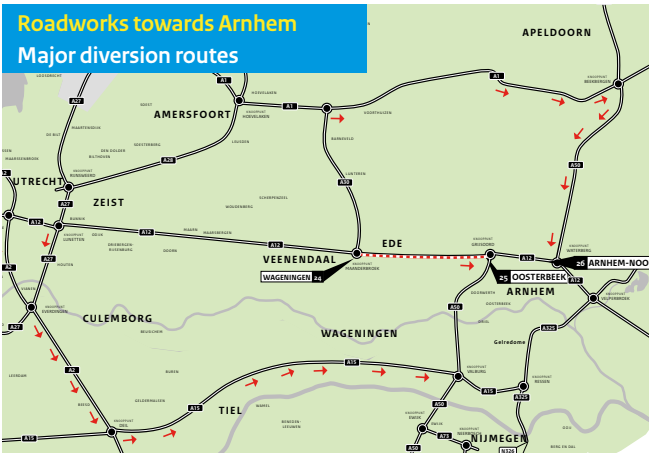
Weekend closure

- Friday 20 May 09.00 pm until Monday 23 May 05.00 am

For less inconvenience:

- Use the diversion routes via Beekbergen interchange (A1/A50) or Deil interchange (A2/A15).
- On Saturday 21 and Sunday 22 May, take into account additional travel time due to a risk of delays / queues on the diversion routes; leave early if required.

A12 towards Utrecht: closures between Grijsoord interchange and the Wageningen connection (24)

Including the Oosterbeek (25) access road towards Utrecht and the Wageningen (24) and Oosterbeek (25) exits coming from the direction of Arnhem.

- Saturday 9 April 10.00 pm until Sunday 10 April 09.00 am
- Saturday 23 April 10.00 pm until Sunday 24 April 09.00 am

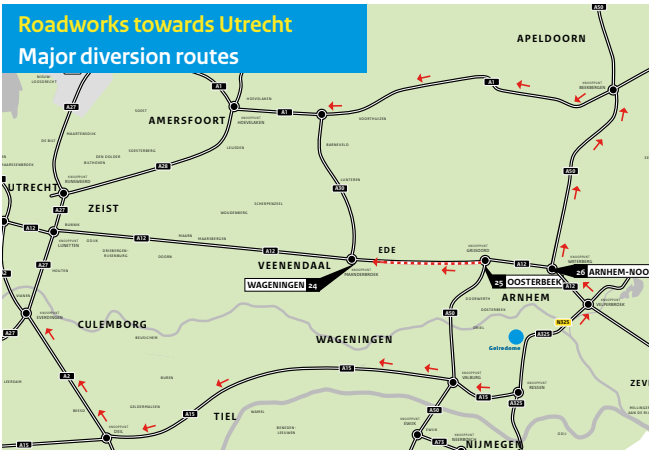
Weekend closure

- Friday 17 June 09.00 pm until Monday 20 June 05.00 am

For less inconvenience:

- Use the diversion routes via Beekbergen interchange (A50/A1) or Deil interchange (A15/A2).
- On Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 June, take into account additional travel time due to a risk of delays / queues on the diversion routes; leave early if required.

Please note: Visitors to Gelredome on 18 June: there will be special diversion routes on the way back

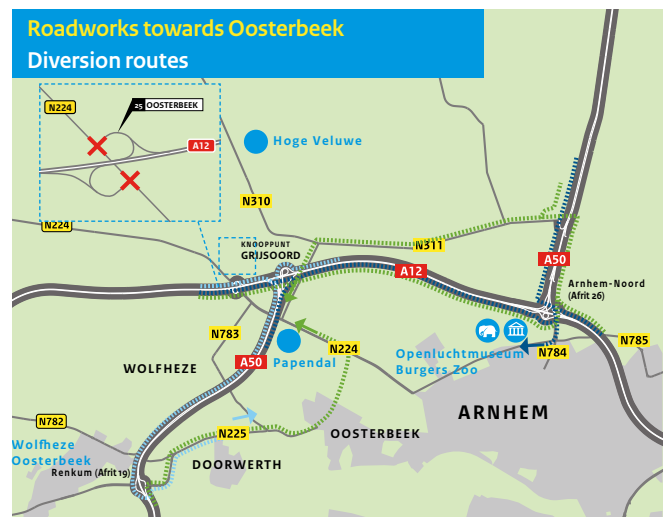
Oosterbeek / N224 provincial road connection

From the night of Friday 29 April until the morning of Monday 2 May, the Oosterbeek (25) and N224 connection will be closed. During this weekend, the N224 at the A12 will be closed to motorised traffic. Cyclists and pedestrians will be able to pass. The access and exit roads of the connection will be closed both in the direction of Arnhem / Oberhausen and Utrecht.

Wolfheze / Oosterbeek	via A50 connection Renkum (19)
Ede	via A12 connection 24 and possibly A30 exit 2
